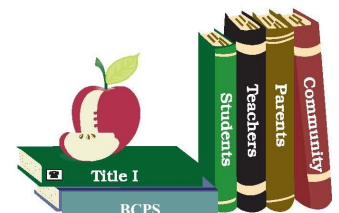
Parents will be given an overview of the School Progress Plan for 2016-17.
